HLCW Minutes September 11, 2018

The meeting was called to order by President Grace Autio following the bible study which took place at 10:00 a.m. Ten members were present.

The minutes of the May meeting were approved as published in the church Beacon upon motion made by Dawn Shafer, seconded by Shirley Johnson and all voting in favor.

Jeanette Johnsen's treasurer report showed a balance May 4, 2018 of \$783.88. After income totaling \$603.19 and expenses of \$1,098.27 the checking balance was \$288.80. With a savings balance of \$635.91 after designated funds of \$64.69, the remaining available funds are \$860.02. Jeanette Johnsen noted in her report that all camper funds are gone at this time. President Grace asked for a vote on the report and all voted aye.

Grace reported a letter from former residents the Juhl family of Fergus Falls, who are serving as missionaries in Arsin, Africa, in the northeastern part of that country.

NEW BUSINESS: Will we make and sell apple pies this year? The vote was a unanimous 'yes.' The date set for the project is Thursday and Friday, October 11 and 12, and the apples will be purchased from a Bayfield orchard as usual; and Bob and Carolyn Hosking and Roy and Grace Autio will be going after the apples on October 10th.
