Pastor John Burgess opened with prayer.

Meeting was called to order at 8:05 AM by Bubba Vance.

Approval of Agenda

Pastors Report

Pastor Burgess provided a written report: National Day of Prayer is May 6. Baccalaureate for the community graduates is May 26 at Four Rivers Church. Confirmation for Summer Johnson and Hannah Zieroth is May 23. Pastor has a funeral May 14 in Cromwell. Pastor will attend an LCMC Symposium June 4 – 6 in Livingston Montana. Community VBS for Floodwood will be June 14 - 18. Pastor will attend the LCMC National annual gathering in October 3 – 6 and Pastor and Cindy will be able to visit their family as well. Pastor has a visit scheduled with Lilly Autio this week and next week he will visit Lois and Lorraine in Cromwell.

Administrator's Report

Report was provided in packet, A gift donation of \$750 was received to cover the cost of the organ repair (deposit included in general checking account). Total Globe offering for Souper Bowl of Caring was \$381.88 for the Life House in Duluth. The Good Friday Service Offering for the Police Department Fund was \$394.00. The Police department has paid some water and sewer bills with it. Food Distribution Thursday April 15, 130 boxes distributed in about 45 minutes. Thank you, Volunteers! Next one is Thursday, May 15, will probably be the last one as Government is ending the program. CCLI report completed for 6 month time period, which is a tally of all songs sung at church between these dates. Quarterly elevator inspection was completed, no issues reported.
