April 24, 2022

Pastor John opened with prayer.

Meeting was called to order at 8:06 AM by Bubba Vance

Appoint New Council Member -

Kim Hutchinson has agreed to complete 1 year of a three-year term (ending Jan 2025) and can run for election to complete 2 years at January 2023 Annual Meeting. Motion made Mark Johnsen, second by Tanya Johnson to approve Kim Hutchinson to the Council position. Motion carried.

Approval of Agenda

Motion made by Carolyn Hosking, second by Mark Johnsen to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Secretaries Report

February 27, 2022 Church Council minutes in packet. Motion to approve by Deb Tollgaard, second by Mark Johnsen. Motion carried.

Pastor's Report

Pastor Burgess reported delivering 20 Communions distributed.

Religious release is done for the year, special thanks to all who helped make it a success. Special thanks to all who helped with the Lenten soup suppers, and dramas to make it such a success. Special thanks to the youth and youth committee who made the Easter egg hunt and breakfast a success. Attendance at Easter was 75 which is the largest since COVID started. Pastor participated in the Good Friday service at the Baptist church. It was well attended. Held the funeral for Lois Hendrickson and over 150 people attended. Community Prayer walk will be May 5th at 6:30 pm in conjunction with the National Day of Prayer. There will be a Baccalaureate service for the Graduates May 18 at 7:00 pm at the New Life Church. Pastor will lead the prayers for the Memorial Day Services in the various cemeteries.

Motion by Tanya Johnson, second by Mark Johnsen to return to the old method (Pre-COVID) of Communion. Motion carried. (Prepackaged cup with bread/wine will still be available for those who prefer that way.)

Treasurers Report and Administrator's Report

Expenses are up and funds and donations are down. 2021 Audit is being completed by Kathy Johnsen and Tim Tollgaard during this meeting. A new refrigerator was purchased for the Parsonage \$1,428.00, funds came from the rental account. A new screen for the projector was purchased and installed and it seems brighter. We are now using a Bluetooth device to send sound from the laptop to the PA system. It works well and eliminates the buzz (feedback noise). The elevator passed the

Load Test on March 28, tested with 3125 pounds. (That test is good for 5 years.) The picnic table is here \$699, it was cheaper than expected. A chain will be purchased, and it will be chained to the tree so that it is not taken. Final signatures on Corporate Resolution required. Rimmereid Social Security paperwork is being requested for 1998, 1999

Motion by Mark Johnsen, second by Carolyn Hosking to approve the February and March 2022 Check Registers, Financial Reports, and the verbal report. Motion carried.
