FOOD DISTRIBUTION (Continued from Page 2) program and is provided/transported to us by AEOA out of Virginia. (Jeff Kletscher is the AEOA Board Chair.) Special thanks goes to AEOA for remembering the Floodwood Area.

In Floodwood we have given away 865 boxes equaling about 16,925 pounds. In the area that AEOA has been providing the food, a total of 58 semi loads, totaling 88,424 boxes and 2,091,986 pounds will have been distributed by the end of May.

The current food program that provides food to AEOA is scheduled to end at the end of May. But, AEAO staff has shared with Jeff that there are rumors that a new food program is being considered by the USDA.
