Pastor Burgess opened with prayer.

Meeting was called to order at 8:03 AM by Jeff Kletscher for purposes of electing officers.

Reorganization

Election of Officers - President: Nominations were requested regarding officers. Missy Wojtysiak was asked to step up as President and she declined. Todd Messner was nominated and he declined. Gary Gustafson was nominated and he declined. Remaining council members were asked if any of them were willing to fill the President position. Tanya Johnson is willing to serve as President if someone else is willing to be Secretary. Missy Wojtysiak offered to fill the Secretary position. Deb Tollgaard was asked prior to be the meeting if she would continue to be treasurer and accepted. Gary Gustfason is willing to be the Vice President. Kim Hutchinson made a motion to approve election to these positions, second by Todd Messner. Motion carried.

Secretaries Report

January 21, 2024 Church Council minutes and January 28, 2024 Annual Meeting minutes in packet. Motion to approve by Missy Wojtysiak, second by Kim Hutchinson. Motion carried.

Pastor's Report

Pastors' mileage was 119 and he distributed 16 communions. The Funeral for Floyd Ahlgren will be March 18th at 11 am. This also happens to have been Floyd's birthday. Carole has requested a typical church funeral luncheon that will be provided after the service. There is a sign up for volunteers. Midweek Lenten services are going well with only around 20 in attendance each week. Thanks to all who participate in soup suppers and dramas. Special thanks to Jeff for filling in for Pastor Feb 28th. Today will be installation of council members the church service. Religious Release will have only 2 more classes. Special thanks to all who helped so much this year. Good Friday service will be at the St. Louis Catholic Church March 29th at 7 pm this year. We will have the Maundy Thursday service March 28th at 7 pm with communion. No soup supper that evening. Special thanks to the youth for all their help during Lent, Spring Night Out, and upcoming

Easter egg hunt and Easter breakfast.

Treasurers Report and Administrator's Report

January and February 2024 check registers included. Nothing new noted, expenses as expected. February 2024 Financial Report, nothing unusual. Reviewed the Endowment fund and the last quarter of 2023 showed an increase. Total as of December 31, 2023 was \$102,591.14. Religious release fund remains the same. John, Todd and Nathan have been busy fixing and updating light bulbs and tubes, exit light bulbs and batteries. Also, projector positioning, installing a switch for lights by screen, and outlet in the overflow room and expansion tank and pressure gauge on the boiler. Souper Bowl of Caring offering totaled \$972.00 which Jeff Kletscher will mail a check to the Life House for. Total amount of food donated is still pending. Quake Event Offering totaled \$222.79 and will be transferred to the Youth Account. Jeff will be visiting his family over Easter and Tanya will be running the projector during the service.

Discussion on working to close Cub Scout Troop #120 Account, which has been unused since June 2019. Jeff will reach out to Dan High (former Cub Scout Troop Leader) to get his input on how to distribute the funds. Council agrees now is the time to close account and encourages Jeff to make it happen.

Proposed splitting it 3 ways, One at \$20,000 (from general checking), one at \$15,000 (from general savings) and one at \$25,000 (from rental account). Jeff Kletscher will continue to look into this and continue forward if no major obstacles arise. Motion to approve made by Kim Hutchinson, second by Gary Gustafson. Motion carried.
- d. New air conditioners (mini-splits) needed for Parsonage. Unable to get quote thus far from Floodwood Gas. Missy Wojtysiak will speak with

- her uncle and attempt to get an estimate from him for this
- e. Birthday/Anniversary cards – a concern was brought forth regarding the Birthday/Anniversary list for the newsletter and whether it needed to be "cleaned up" in regards to people who have moved or now attend elsewhere. A discussion was held and decided no changes to be made as it is a reminder to continue to pray for these people or wish them well and that may be just the friendly reminder they need from their friends at Hope Lutheran.


