reetings Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

October is here, cool, crisp fall air leaves make brilliant color changes and orange pumpkins abound. Fall is a time of change. The first change you will see at church is on October 1, when Neil Vance will be providing the sermon via recorded video. I will be at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Mansfield, Ohio, our church home for over twenty years. I have been asked to be the guest preacher for their 75th anniversary celebration.

For us Lutherans it is Reformation month, a time we remember the changes of Martin Luther and the Christian doctrines he rediscovered that so many of us Protestants believe in today. For a change from the lectionary readings, I will be doing a series on Martin Luther and the Reformation this October in which I will again invite Martin Luther to share his beliefs with us. I invite you all to come and attend Sunday Worship services as I portray Martin and teach you in his words from 500 years ago the cornerstones of our Lutheran Beliefs. We will explore what it means to have JUSTIFICATION BY FAITH ALONE AND THAT SALVATION IS A FREE GIFT GOD GIVES TO THOSE WHO HAVE FAITH. We will also look at the life of Martin Luther and some of his most famous quotes and his treatise about the Bondage of the Will. On Reformation Sunday October 29, we will relive his nailing the 95 theses on the door of the church in Wittenburg and his discussion of why he did this. This should be a rewarding series for any Lutheran Christian.

October, Reformation Month

Artin Luther was a German monk and Professor of Theology at the University of Wittenberg. Luther sparked the Reformation in 1517 by posting, his "95 Theses" on the door of the Castle Church in Wittenberg, Germany - these theses were a list of statements that expressed Luther's concerns about certain Church practices - largely the sale of indulgences, but they were based on Luther's deeper concerns with Church doctrine.

The reformers rejected the authority of the pope as well as many of the principles and practices of Catholicism of that time. The essential tenets of the Reformation are that the Bible is the sole authority for all matters of faith and conduct and that salvation is by God's grace and by faith in Jesus Christ.
